The celebration successfully fostered constitutional awareness, unity, and a sense of responsibility among students





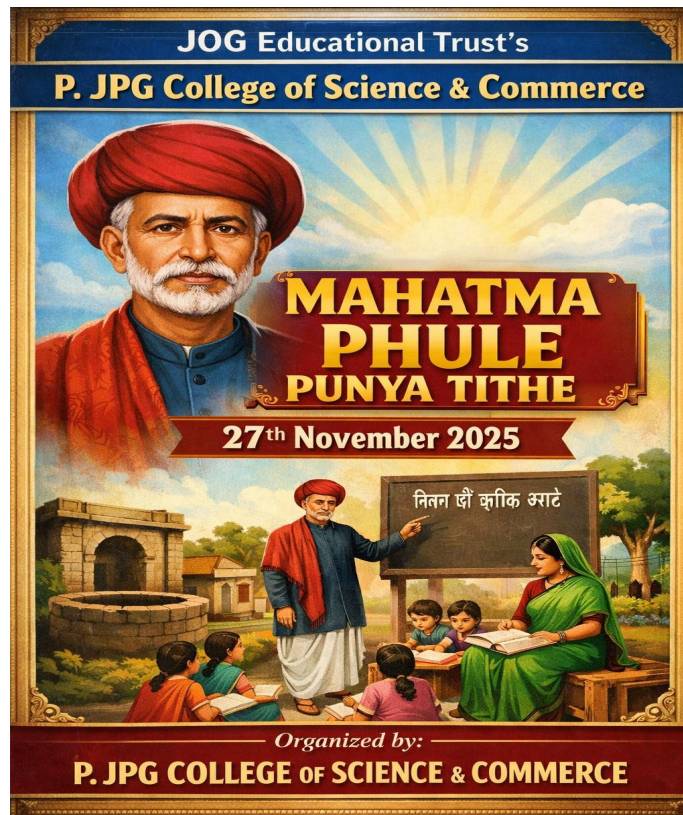

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SHANTATA PUNE VACHAT AHE

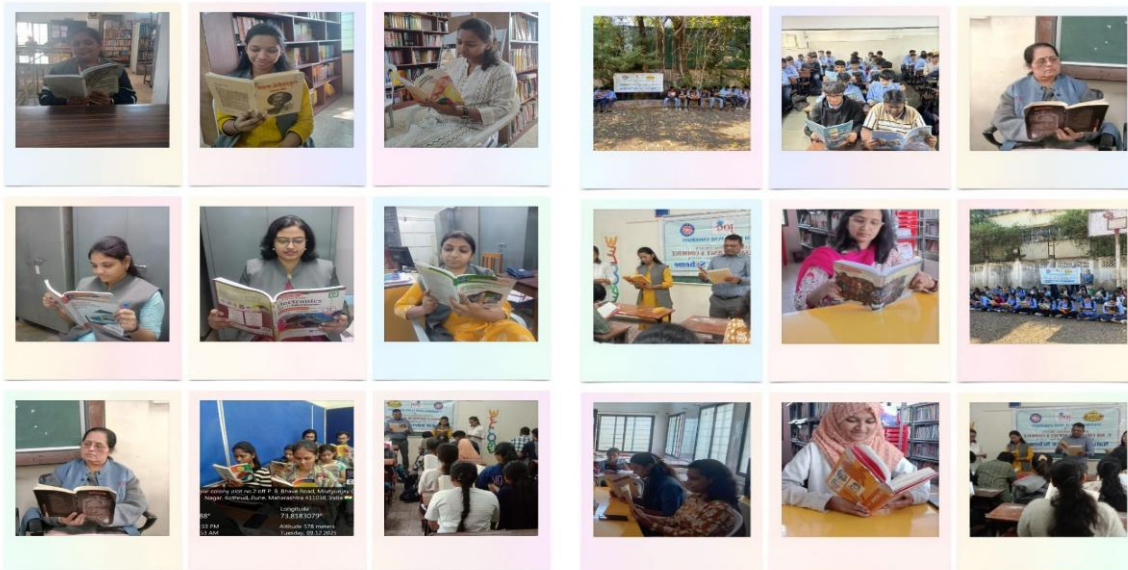
9th December 2025
